Surrey Sports Park opened in April 2010. Built by the University of Surrey, this £36m elite training venue is a sporting hub in the South East of Britain. Its location, being close to London and both major airports gives it an advantage over many other training venues.

Surrey Sports Park has facilitated many training camps in rugby, football, swimming, basketball and netball as well as hosting many national and international events, most notably the IRB Women's Rugby World Cup 2010, the Rathbones Women's Lacrosse World Cup 2017 and the IRF Roundnet World Championships in 2024, where we hosted the largest international competition yet, on behalf of British Roundnet.

- Size: 700sq m.
- 120 Stations, including the latest CV equipment with integrated TV and entertainment systems, fixed resistance machines and free weights.
- Zoned areas tailored to members with different requirements.
- World class, Olympic standard equipment to cater for our elite athletes.
- 9 Olympic lifting platforms.

THREE MULTI-PURPOSE SPORTS HALLS

- Size: 34m x 18m (Halls A and B set as Performance Arena 34m x 36m).
- Individually available as 3 separate halls, ideal as training facilities or multi-sport use.
- Electronic retractable bleacher seating for 820 people, with additional seating for up to 200 people available.
- Fully sprung wooden floor.
- Suitable for basketball, badminton, netball, volleyball, martial arts, archery, fencing, table tennis and trampolining (list not exhaustive).
- All equipment complies with National Governing Body standards.
- Floor anchors for gymnastic equipment.

INDOOR SWIMMING POOL

- Size: 50m x 20m.
- 8 x 2.5m wide lanes.
- Traversable boom enabling the pool to become 2 x 25m sections, or 30m long for water polo.
- Moveable floor enabling the depth of the water to change. Whilst the pool is 2m deep throughout, it can change and rise to any depth up to deck level.
- Daktronics timing system and wall mounted 4m x 2m video screen.
- OSB12 starting platforms with athletic start and relay break detection.
- UV water treatment system.
- Wet side changing village dedicated to pool users.
- Multiple accessibility aids for pool entry.

TWO LARGE MULTI-PURPOSE EXERCISE STUDIOS

- Size: 15m x 12m (individual).
- Size: 15m x 24m (retractable wall open).
- Fully sprung wooden floor.
- Mirrored walls with drapes.
- Suitable for dance, group fitness, martial arts or a team meeting space.
- Suitable for mass catering.

THE TREATMENT ROOM

• Two individual rooms offering sports massage, sports therapy, osteopathy and physiotherapy.

SIX GLASS-BACKED SQUASH COURTS

- 2 show courts with electronic, retractable seating for 132 spectators and Daktronics scoring system.
- 4 courts with permanent raised bench seating.

CLIMBING CENTRE

- 12m overhanging competition wall
- Resin-featured lead wall suitable for lessons, social climbers or children's parties.
- Abseiling ledge.
- Extensive bouldering wall, incorporating a bouldering cave suitable for advanced climbers.
- 4 TrueBlue Auto Belays.

OUTDOOR FACILITIES

- 3 Artificial turf pitches, including two 3G rubber crumb pitches.
- 6 grass football/rugby pitches.
- 8 floodlit tennis courts.

SPINNING STUDIO

- Contains 25 Spinning bikes (including instructor).
- Fully equipped with AV and multi - coloured LED lighting.

ON SITE CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

The Surrey Sports Park is serviced by a large number of University of Surrey modern accommodation rooms on site (not available all year around).

- The rooms are single, en suite with internet connection.
- They are in clusters of 5-8 around a shared kitchen area.

HOSTING ELITE SPORTS EVENTS & PROFESSIONAL TEAMS

RFUW WORLD CUP 2010

- Surrey Sports Park hosted the 2010 Women's Rugby World Cup.
- 12 teams from around the world spent 3 weeks living, training and performing here.
- All match and training pitches, accommodation, catering, physiotherapy and team rooms were supplied and maintained by SSP.

ENGLAND SQUASH AND RACKETBALL

- Surrey Sports Park is the London and South East centre for Squash and Racketball.
- It was the venue for the England County Finals.

GUILDFORD CITY SWIMMING CLUB

- Guildford City Swimming Club is based at Surrey Sports Park.
- GCSC were the South East Regional National Swimming League Champions for 4 straight years from 2005-2008.
- GCSC employs 2 ASA Level 4 coaches, plus 13 professionally qualified ASACoaches & Teachers, including its own in-house chartered physiotherapist and nutritionist.

LACROSSE WORLD CUP 2017

- 24 teams worldwide.
- Hosted & accommodated here for 2 weeks.
- All match/training pitches, accommodation, catering and meeting rooms were supplied & maintained by SSP.

IRF ROUNDNET WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The 2024 world championships saw 650 players, 40 volunteers and 1,100 spectators descend on Surrey Sports Park.
- Across the weekend 3,100 matches were played, bringing the largest international competition, since COVID, back to Surrey.
- The economic impact of the event on the local area was huge and hosting this event really highlighted how much the Sports Park had missed hosting events of this scale.

- They have access to the 120 station fitness suite, making use of the Olympic standard heavy weights area and strength and conditioning facilities, as well as their own dedicated outdoor facilities.
- Harlequins link into the University of Surrey Rugby club to develop players and improve pathways into elite sport.

SURREY SCORCHERS 2015 - 2024

- Surrey Sports Park operated a British Basketball League team in the top level competition nationally.
- All training sessions and home games were held at SSP.
- Players and coaches from the club linked in with the University Basketball Club, running all training and coaching.

SURREY STORM NETBALL 2010 - 2024

- Surrey Sports Park operated a Super League Netball team in England Netball's top level competition.
- All training sessions and matches took place at SSP.
- Athletes had full access to the fitness suite and work with the catering team to develop nutritionally balanced diets.

GB BASKETBALL

• GB Women's basketball were based at Surrey Sports Park for their training camps and test matches in 2010 & 2011.

LOCATION

Surrey Sports Park is situated in the historic town of Guildford at the University of Surrey, just 40 minutes from London.

Located only 25 miles from London Heathrow Airport and 40 miles from London Gatwick Airport, Surrey Sports Park is easily accessible for international guests and athletes from around the world. Guildford is ideally situated only 10 miles from the M25, one of the UK's best connected motorway networks, linking the London and the South East with the rest of England, Wales and Scotland.

There are two car parks available to members and guests using the facilities from 06:00 – 22:30, weekdays and 07:00 - 22:00 weekends. The car parks are currently managed through restrictions that limit overnight parking but allow parking throughout the day. In addition, there are 11 disabled bays, a drop off/pick up area, facilities for motorbikes and larger bays for up to 4 coaches and 6 minibuses to park.
